DOG LICENSES (Sec. 22-338 thru 22-352):

Neutered male, spayed female - \$ 8.00 of which \$2.00 is to be sent to the State Animal Population Control Fund

Male, female - \$ 19.00 of which \$6.00 is to be sent to the State Animal Population Control Fund

Late licensing penalty - \$ 1.00 per month or fraction thereof

Transfer of ownership - \$ 1.00 for new license/tag if already licensed

Lost tag - \$.50

Change of residence (town) - \$.50 for new license/tag

Kennel licenses - \$ 50.00 plus .10 per tag for 10 tags
- \$100.00 plus .10 per tag for more than 10 tags

Guide dog - FREE

The town clerk shall retain \$1.00 for each license issued, \$2.00 for each kennel license issued, and .50 for each replacement tag issued.

HUNTING, TRAPPING AND SPORT FISHING LICENSES

All licenses are valid for the calendar year, except pheasant tags which are valid from October through February.

All licenses expire on December 31 of the year issued. Firearms hunting, fishing and trapping licenses are still issued free to residents 65 and older who meet hunter education requirements. But, these licenses must now be renewed annually.
