Dan provided the following information on the Pay loader, along with copies of some work orders showing repairs.

Bill the overall condition for a 15 year old loader is good it's starting to rust out around the cab and cab floor at this point it's not affecting the operation of the machine it would be a good machine to keep for a spare for are winter operations.

The lead time for us to get a new loader is over 12 months, the dealer will not guarantee a delivery date based on the supply chain issues. If the current Pay Loader goes out of service we would have to rely solely on the backhoe for moving materials, loading trucks, snow operations , etc. However we could potentially call on local contractors for assistance if needed.
