CoventryVision Committee Meeting
February 7, 2021

The meeting was called to order at 6:33 PM by Committee Chair Konrad Mroczek.

Projects:

- The flag ceremony is done. Francis has footage of the bench dedication and flag burning ceremony.
- Francis wants to re-shoot the Library Coventry Conversations segment.
- A Community Conversation segment with Manny Rodrigues is pending. Contact information has been sent to Francis.
- We have some Farmers' Market footage and the Committee would like to get more and do a spotlight piece this summer. Laura indicated that there may be some turnover on the Market's operating committee in the near future, so it would be a good idea to reach out soon.

Video Coverage:

- The Town Council budget dates have been set for March, and video coverage is needed. Konrad will review the [schedule](#) and advise if back-up assistance is needed.
- Other events were discussed for possible coverage. The Memorial Day parade is covered frequently and is not a target for filming this year, unless some members plan to attend anyway and want to film some b-roll. The CoventryFest event appears to be happening this year, and that has not been filmed recently. The date of that event is 6/25 in Patriots Park. Schedule not yet announced but will be available on the Coventry Cares LLC [social media](#).
- The Ice Fishing class has already taken place, but b-roll footage might be possible as many people are still out on the ice.
- Other Recreation programs for possible coverage can be found on the Recreation Department's seasonal [program brochure](#). Ideas or new initiatives from committee members are welcome.
