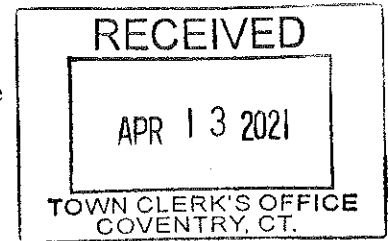


Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee

Regular Meeting Minutes
ZOOM video conference



Call to Order – A regular meeting of the Coventry Lake Advisory & Monitoring Committee was called to order on Monday, April 12, 2021 at 7:04 p.m. via ZOOM video conference by Chair Debby Zeppa. Other members present were Laurie Felix, Scott Gallo, Suzanne Choate, Carly Imhoff, and Bill Piotroski.
