## RESIDENT BEACH PASS INFORMATION

### AVAILABLE FOR PURCHASE AT TOWN HALL & PATRIOTS PARK DURING OPERATING HOURS

The Parks & Recreation Office is located at the Coventry Town Hall, 1712 Main Street, Coventry.

Office Hours for Permit sales are:

Monday – Wednesday: 8:30am – 4pm; Thursday: 8:30am – 6pm; and Friday: 8:30am – 12:30pm

#### Seasonal Beach Parking Pass – Place on windshield passenger side, lower corner

- \$25 for 1<sup>st</sup> vehicle
- \$12 for each additional vehicle
- State sales tax included

Coventry Senior Citizens shall receive a free hanging-parking pass for access to Patriots Park and Lisicke Beach parking lots, at no charge for weekdays (M-F ONLY).

**\*\*\*This parking pass is not accepted on weekends\*\*\***

## **A One-Day Guest Parking Pass – For Residents & Guests of Residents**

- \$5/day per car
- Must be pre purchased at the Parks and Rec Office by the Coventry Resident
- Must be for specific day

### **THE FOLLOWING IS REQUIRED AT THE TIME OF PURCHASE:**

#### **1. Completed application**

2. **A copy of the vehicle registration** for each vehicle for which a Permit is required. A copy of the tax bill is required with leased vehicle. If your vehicle is registered to a business, documentation linking you to the business is required.

If you purchase a new vehicle and need a new Permit (even if you transfer the license plates to the new car), you will need to submit a copy of your vehicle registration.

#### **If your car is not registered in Coventry**

1. **Renter** – bring a copy of your car registration and lease agreement listing Coventry address
2. **Coventry Business Owner** – bring a copy of your car registration and documentation proving ownership (deed, lease agreement, ect)
3. **New Resident** – bring a copy of your car registration and a piece of mail with your Coventry address
4. **Caregiving of Resident (Babysitter/Nanny)** – bring a copy of your car registration, driver's license and a letter from your employer with their Coventry address listed

#### **3. Payment**

- Cash
- Check made payable to the “Town of Coventry”
- Credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, and Discover) are accepted at the Parks and Rec Office. A 3% transition fee is applied.

## **Beach Rules & Regulations**

- No swimming when lifeguard is off duty
  - No fishing from the shore
  - No launching boats inside swim area
  - No full face swim masks, tubes or floats
  - No littering – take your trash
  - No nudity
  - No open fires
  - No alcohol
  - No animals, except service animals
  - No rough play
  - No loud radios/music
  - No swimming outside marked swim area
  - No glass bottles
  - No feeding the wildlife
  - No smoking/vaping – cigarettes and marijuana

- Park only in designated parking areas – please stay off the grass.
  - Bathing suits required, no cut-offs or street clothes in the water.
  - All infants and toddlers must wear swim diapers.
  - Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult
