



INLAND WETLANDS PERMIT TO CONDUCT REGULATED ACTIVITIES

REASON FOR DECISION: The applicant has demonstrated the following:

- Implementation of erosion and sedimentation controls measures to protect the regulated areas.
- Installation of a storm water mitigation feature – rain garden

PERMIT CONDITIONS:

- Hold a preconstruction meeting with the applicant and any other subcontractors prior to the start of activities to review construction sequencing.
- Inspection erosion and sedimentation control prior to the soil disturbances, except for what is necessary to install said measures
- The applicant/owner shall submit to the Wetlands Agent a proof of inspection for each storm water mitigation feature once a year in the spring on a form to be provided by the Town of Coventry Wetlands Staff.
- Additional erosion and sedimentation controls maybe required as site conditions/weather warrant by the Wetlands Agent staff.

No person shall conduct any regulated activity within an inland wetland or watercourse which requires zoning or subdivision approval without first having obtained a valid certificate of zoning or subdivision approval, special permit, special exception, variance, or other documentation establishing that the proposal complies with the zoning or subdivision requirements adopted by the municipality pursuant to Chapters 124 to 126 of the Connecticut General Statutes inclusive; or any special act, including permits as required under Federal Army Corps of Engineers and the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection.
