

Home Energy Solutions (HES)



A HES home energy assessment provides homeowners and renters with services and installed products that will help make homes more energy efficient and lower their energy bills.

What does an Home Energy Assessment consist of?

- The home energy checkup begins with important safety tests on your furnace and water heater.
- A blower-door test which pinpoints critical drafts and air leaks. After they are found, the contractor will professionally seal them during the visit.
- A duct test to assess air leaks within the ductwork system is performed if you have forced air or central air conditioning. Then they seal the leaks to reduce the drafts.
- The technician may install hot water-saving devices, including low-flow showerheads and faucet aerators (subject to program caps).
- Rebates for qualifying central air conditioning systems and for replacement of certain inefficient appliances with qualifying energy-efficient models.
- Installation of energy-efficient compact fluorescent light bulbs.
- Incentives for insulation upgrades.
